



## WASHINGTON CITY ADOPT-YOUR-CITY APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT

Washington City hereafter called the “City” and the \_\_\_\_\_ hereafter called the “Group” recognizing the need and desirability of a litter free and maintained City, are entering this agreement to permit the Group to contribute toward the effort of maintaining the beauty and safety of Washington City within their adopted location.

By signature below, the Group acknowledges the hazardous nature of the work and agrees to hold Washington City harmless from liability in the event of an accident of other incident involving death or injury to any member of the group or others, or property damage.

**The Group further agrees to the following provisions:**

1. Participants working along roadways shall be at least eleven (11) years old. When the participants are fifteen (15) years of age or younger, the group shall furnish adequate supervision at the ratio of one (1) adult for every five (5) children.
2. Each Group will be given safety instructions by the designated City representative which will include the following:
  - A) Volunteers must stay off the traveled area of the roadway.
  - B) If traveled area is to be crossed, it must be done by the group together, with proper flagging and supervision.
  - C) Projects will only be done during daylight hours.
  - D) Participants must attend a safety meeting conducted by the Group before participation in a roadside clean up.
  - E) Groups shall adopt a City location for a minimum of two (2) years.
  - F) Groups shall perform their required tasks (pick up litter) a minimum of three (3) times a year. One of these times may be designated by the City with thirty (30) days notice to the Group.
  - G) The Group shall obtain required supplies and materials from the City representative during regular business hours.
  - H) The Group shall place filled trash bags at the edge of the shoulder of the road for pick up, as they become full. Bags are to be tied. Torn bags are to be placed inside another bag and tied.
  - I) Unused material and supplies furnished by the City shall be returned to the City within one (1) week following clean up.

**The City agrees to accomplish the following:**

1. Erect a sign at each end of the adopted section of roadway or other location with the Groups name or acronym displayed.
2. Provide orange vests, trash bags, safety training and literature.
3. Remove the filled trash bags the first workday after the project is completed.

4. Remove large, heavy, hazardous, or otherwise unusual litter from the project location.

If in the sole judgment the City Department, it is determined that the adopting Group is not meeting the terms and conditions of this agreement, upon thirty (30) days notice the City may terminate the adoption agreement and remove the signs.

The City recognizes the Group as the adopting organization for the designated project location described as \_\_\_\_\_ and are responsible for picking up litter at this location and promoting a litter-free environment in the community for a period beginning \_\_\_\_\_ and ending \_\_\_\_\_. (minimum of two (2) years)

We certify that we have read, understood and will abide by all the foregoing provisions of this agreement.
